This one-day training is designed to introduce the basics of primary prevention to new prevention specialists or prevention specialists who want a refresher on primary prevention. Participants will learn the Spectrum of Prevention model and gain insight concerning its application, explore prevention ethics, and explore primary prevention theory. Practical, hands-on application of concepts learned will be interwoven throughout the training based on participants' needs.

Training Objectives:

- Understand and articulate definitions of primary, secondary and tertiary prevention as they are related to primary prevention of sexual and intimate partner violence
- Differentiate between *primary* prevention and other forms of prevention and intervention
- Identify ethical issues pertaining to delivery of primary prevention services
