State Rape Crisis Fund

Ohio's State Rape Crisis Fund provides critical funding for Ohio's rape crisis centers. Part of Ohio's biennial state budget, the Rape Crisis Fund is the only dedicated state funding source that enables centers to provide both prevention and response services.

Advocate Privilege

OAESV is advocating for privileged communications between survivors and rape crisis advocates. Advocate privilege would ensure that survivors have access to confidential support services without fear of their privacy being compromised.
