

We may be established in our new home, but you can still support our mission and initiatives by moving with us!



## Public Policy Advocacy: your efforts are making a difference!

OAESV is advocating for Advocate Privilege in Ohio. We believe that survivors deserve access to advocacy services without having to worry about what they say in their pursuit of support and healing. Advocate Privilege would provide for protected communications between rape crisis advocates and survivors, something that numerous other states already have in place.







House Bill 377, better known as Erin's Law, would require sexual abuse prevention education in grades K-6, would add sexual violence prevention education in grades 7-12, and would require additional training for school personnel on sexual abuse prevention. In December, OAESV Survivor Advisory Council member Pam Prisbylla joined Communications Director Becky Perkins in testifying in support of House Bill 377. Want to share your voice? 
#### TRAINING INSTITUTE FOR ADVOCATES
