
# IDENTITY MATTERS LANGUAGE MATTERS

- 3. GENDER EXPRESSION
- 4. GENDER



#### Historical Roots

## Gay-

- 13<sup>th</sup> Century: joyous or brightly colored
- 16<sup>th</sup> Century: first sexuality reference, hedonistic, frivolous; brothels became "gay houses"
- 18<sup>th</sup> Century: noble, fine, The Art of Poetry was "the Gay Science"
- 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Century: 1920's-1<sup>st</sup> use of it for a gay man as an effort to name it and criminalize it began in the United States, forcing gay language into the closet, mixing with Polari, a secret gay language
