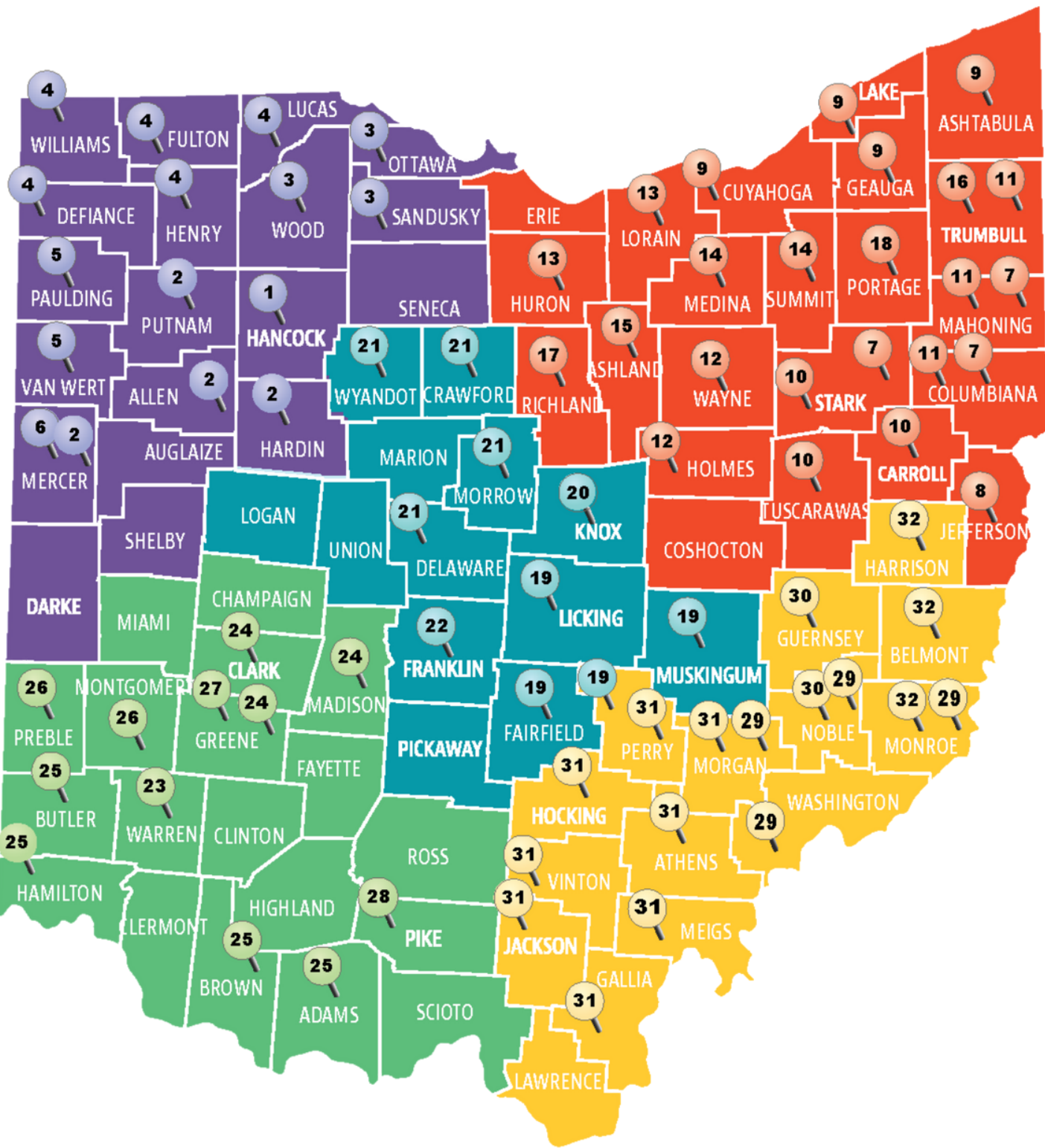

Who is OAESV?

As Ohio's statewide coalition, OAESV advocates for comprehensive responses and rape crisis services for survivors and empowers communities to prevent sexual violence.

Overarching Objectives

End isolation of survivors and agencies working on their behalf

Improve services and responses to survivors and all those impacted by sexual violence,

Increase public awareness about sexual violence,

Inform and shape public policy,

Core Standards

In 2016, the Ohio Alliance to End Sexual Violence (OAESV) created, “The Core Standards for Rape Crisis Programs in Ohio” in partnership with a committee of experienced professionals working directly with survivors of sexual violence and providing administration of rape crisis services in Ohio. This document serves as the authoritative document on the delivery of rape crisis services in Ohio.

Core Standards

1. To ensure that every survivor in the state of Ohio has access to consistent services regardless of personal or demographic characteristics, or location in the state

2. To provide a formalized framework for identifying and describing specific services and characteristics that define a rape crisis program in Ohio

3. To serve as a resource for rape crisis programs in terms of training for staff and volunteers, continuing education, and best practices.

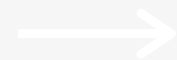
Provides Training & Technical Assistance.
