How does this individual learn best?

Jane learns best through conversation. When asked questions, she may not respond right away and needs time to process and will eventually answer. She also needs someone working with her that is calm, a good listener and very patient. She also enjoys watching videos but may need help processing the information.

How do you evaluate this individual's comprehension?
