About Internship

Under the guidance of the Statewide Director of Forensic Nursing, this internship position will assist with collecting data regarding access to medical forensic examination throughout the state and creating contact resources. This 6-month internship position will commence on May 15, 2025 and require an estimated 5 hours of work per week. This position will pay \$2500.00 for the 4-month contract disbursed monthly by direct deposit. This position is remote with check in meetings with the Director of Forensic Nursing.

- Updating the Ohio Forensic Nurse Resource Map
 - Contacting hospitals to obtain data of services provided
 - Updating current map
 - Working with R & C team for publication
- Resource/Contact Information
 - Obtaining forensic nurse and law enforcement contact information
 - Creating list-serv for law enforcement agencies.
