About Internship

Under the guidance of the Resource & Communications Coordinator, this paid internship position will assist with social media, marketing, graphic design, and content creation for Sexual Assault Awareness Month, Advocacy Day, Annual Conference, and OAESV in general.

This position will focus on content creation including social media, email, print, digital, and an onsite presence. This 5-month internship position will commence early February through early July 2026, and require an estimated 15 hours of work per week. This position is mostly remote, but some travel to Columbus will be required.

Responsibilities

- Sexual Assault Awareness Month (February April)
 - Create graphics to be posted on OAESV social channels
 - Write relevant and compelling captions to go along with each post
 - Create visual and written content based on resources OAESV staff have created
 - Ensure all content follows brand guidelines
- Advocacy Day (February April)
 - Assist with creating an email and social media communications plan to encourage attendance; inspire the public and lawmakers to support survivors and the programs that serve them; and show lawmakers and other stakeholders how they can participate in ending sexual violence and supporting survivors
 - Assist with advertising and designing OAESV's annual t-shirt campaign to raise funds for our public policy efforts
 - Provide day-of coverage by sharing live photos of presenters, attendees, and behindthe-scenes content of OAESV staff
 - Create ready-to-use graphic templates for day-of live coverage
 - Assist in transcribing live quotes and posting to social media channels in real-time
 - Create and send an Advocacy Day thank you email and post

 - Assist with carrying out an email and social media communications plan to encourage registration and share workshop and presenter information
